About Unley Concert Band

Formed in 1997, the **Unley Concert Band (UCB)** is one of the most successful and dynamic community bands in Australia. UCB’s members have a wide age range and diverse backgrounds and come together with the common goal of performing quality band music at a high standard and having fun doing so. UCB has competed with great success in both South Australian and National Band Championships and in 2011, competed for the first time at a National A Grade level. The band relishes performing in community concerts, pageants and tours. In 2009, UCB provided ceremonial music for the Australian Government ANZAC Day commemorations on the Western Front and performed concerts and commemorative performances in Ypres in Belgium, Villers-Bretonneux and Paris. The Unley Concert Band is the 2010 and 2011 A Grade Champion Concert Band of South Australia and is the 2010 Open National Concert Marching champion and the 2011 A Grade National Marching champion, under the direction of Drum Major Jeff Hale.

About Dr Kevin Cameron

Kevin Cameron is an acclaimed Australian conductor and music educator in demand as an adjudicator and guest conductor throughout Australia. Dr Cameron has appeared with the Sydney, Tasmanian, West Australian and Darwin Symphony Orchestras, the State Orchestra of Victoria, the Auckland Philharmonia, the National Orchestra of Ukraine and many youth and community orchestras across Australia. In 1994, he was the inaugural winner of the ABC’s Young Conductor of the Year competition and has subsequently held numerous musical posts, including Assistant Conductor of the Sydney Symphony Orchestra, ABC Conductor in Residence and Music Director positions at Murdoch University, Newcastle University Choir and the University of Newcastle Symphony Orchestra. Dr Cameron has been Music Director of Unley Concert Band since 2001. As an educator, he has held teaching posts in a variety of primary, secondary, and tertiary institutions. He is currently Head of Music at Unity College, Murray Bridge. Dr Cameron has received acknowledgement for his work in community music and music education. In South Australia, he was named the SA Band Association’s Music Director of the Year in 2003 and in 2006 was the recipient of the prestigious SABA Award of Merit. He currently serves as President of the SA Band Association and President of the National Band Council of Australia. Dr Cameron has maintained a passion for music and education and continues to assist the development of musicians through his involvement in professional and community music ensembles as a conductor, coach, adjudicator, advisor, artistic administrator and teacher.
